In September, we held a Town Hall meeting on the Central City Economic Development Sales Tax.

Participants were able to learn about the history of the petition initiative that led to the passage of the tax. Also, attendees were asked to share what projects they would like to see the 1/8th Cent Sales Tax address.

<u>Central City Economic</u> <u>Development Sales Tax</u> <u>Board</u>

In April, the citizens of Kansas City, Missouri went to the polls and passed the Central City Sales Tax Initiative.

This 1/8th cent sales tax was created as a reliable longterm revenue source to help fund various community economic development improvement programs and projects within the boundaries. Those boundaries are 9th Street on the north; Gregory Boulevard on the south; The Paseo on the west; and Indiana on the east.

A five member volunteer economic development tax board will help oversee the use of the funds. Three of the members are appointed by the Mayor of KC and approved by the City Council. Also, one person is appointed by Jackson County and one by the Kansas City Public Schools. The members appointed are as follows:

#ShowIt2Vote

Missouri's new photo ID requirement for voting is now in effect. In all elections going forward, you will be asked to show a photo ID to vote.

There are three ways to vote in Missouri:

- 1. Show a government issued photo ID
- 2. Sign the provided statement and show one of the

following:

Voter Registration Card - ID from a Missouri University, College, vocational or technical school - Utility bill - Bank statement - Government Check - Paycheck - Other Government document showing your name and address

3. Vote a provisional ballot. That ballot becomes valid when a) your signature matches the signature in the voter registry or b) you return to your polling place and show a photo ID

If you don't have a photo ID and want to get one to vote, the State of Missouri will assist you in obtaining one. Call the Hotline at 866.868.3245.
