

2020 VOTING UPDATES:



ABSENTEE

- You can vote **ABSENTEE without a notary** due to:
 - Incapacity or confinement due to illness
 - Having contracted coronavirus or are at-risk (in 2020)
- Ballots **require a notary** if you do not meet specific criteria.
- **October 21 at 5 p.m.** is the deadline to request an **ABSENTEE ballot by mail**; **ABSENTEE** ballots may be requested **in person** up until **November 2**.
- Ballots may be returned **by mail or in person**.
- Ballots must be **received by 7 p.m.** on **Election Day, November 3**.



MAIL-IN

- You can vote by **MAIL-IN** if you are a registered voter.
- **October 21 at 5 p.m.** is the deadline to request and apply for a ballot. You may apply **in person** or **by mail**.
- After receiving your ballot, fill it out and have the envelope notarized.
 - Ballots must be received **by U.S. mail** in time for its receipt **by 7 p.m.** on **Election Day, November 3**.

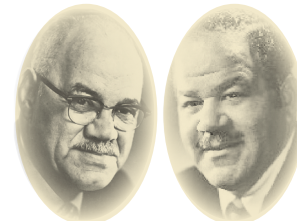
