- Having contracted coronavirus or are at-risk (in 2020)
- Ballots require a notary if you do not meet specific criteria.
- October 21 at 5 p.m. is the deadline to request an
 ABSENTEE ballot by mail; ABSENTEE ballots may be
 requested in person up until November 2.

- Ballots may be returned by mail or in person.
- Ballots must be received by 7 p.m. on Election Day, November 3.

MAIL-IN

- You can vote by MAIL-IN if you are a registered voter.
- October 21 at 5 p.m. is the deadline to request and apply for a ballot. You may apply in person or by mail.
- After receiving your ballot, fill it out and have the envelope notarized.
 - Ballots must be received by U.S. mail in time for its receipt by 7 p.m. on Election Day, November 3.


